Workshop Overview:

This 6 CEU one-day workshop is for therapists of all skill levels. The focus of the workshop will be on how to effectively work with and “use” emotional processing from an adult attachment perspective, specifically within the Emotionally Focused Couples Therapy (EFT) approach. EFT is one of only two empirically validated approaches to treating couple distress and the only one anchored in attachment theory. The presenters will use their own research findings and in-session video segments throughout the day. Small group discussions and role-plays will also be used to make this workshop as clinically relevant and applicable as possible.

Workshop Objectives:

Participants will gain a basic understanding of:

- An EFT/Attachment view of adult intimate relationships
- Working with emotion in initial sessions
- Bringing attachment theory into the session to guide the processing of emotion
- Processing affect inside *and* in-between partners in a couples context

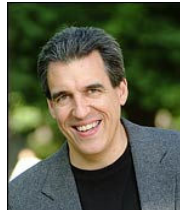

**Brent Bradley, Ph.D.** is associate professor in the Family Therapy Program at the University of Houston-Clear Lake. He has published original research in the *Journal of Marriage and Family Therapy* and is a co-author of *Becoming an Emotionally Focused Couple Therapist: The Workbook*. Dr. Bradley holds two annual externships endorsed by Dr. Susan Johnson and the Ottawa Couple and Family Institute. He is also an active researcher, focusing on how attachment theory and affect focus impact change processes.



**Jim Furrow, Ph.D.** is associate professor in the Department of Marriage and Family Therapy at the Fuller Theological Seminary in Pasadena, CA. He is also the Co-Director at the Center for Research and Child and Adolescent Development. Additionally, Dr. Furrow is a pivotal co-author with Dr. Susan Johnson, Dr. Brent Bradley and others of *Becoming an Emotionally Focused Couple Therapist: The Workbook*. Dr. Furrow and Dr. Bradley hold 32 hour EFT externships in Los Angeles and now, Houston, every year.
