

## Long-Distanced EFT Consultation Procedures

**Note:** *Sometimes I am able to offer consultation, but at other times my plate is full. Thus, we must have an agreement with each other before we start*

I charge \$125 per consultation session.

Please include in a Priority Mail Envelope:

- pertinent background info for me the first time i hear a couple on tape, including a dsm diagnosis for each.
- please fill out a session note form - you can find this on [www.theEFTzone.com](http://www.theEFTzone.com) by clicking the tab "Training" and looking within the "Supervision" section of the page.
- please include a self-addressed postage paid return envelope for Priority Mail within the package you send. A smaller Priority Mail envelope does the trick.
- one blank 120 minute audio cassette tape for me to record onto.
- your session tape (recorded with a "boundary microphone" - see radio shack or ebay. You will need to get one of these – a regular recorder mic will not be enough.)
- i can receive audio or video from you, but I return my supervision on audio cassette.
- a **copy** of a release to tape them (see website, "Training", "Supervision.")
- a **copy** of a release for me to give you consultation with them as clients. You can write this yourself, or you can adjust the group supervision one we have on the above website page to reflect individual consultation.
- a check to me – brent bradley.

I will not cash this check until i have mailed your consultation tapes back to you.

I try to get these back to you within a week, but sometimes that depends on what else is going on. I prefer that you only send another taped session after you've heard my latest consultation tape and have had *two successive sessions with the couple*. I give you a lot on these tapes – you need time to work with the suggestions. Again, one taped session every other week is the fastest pace I am comfortable with. You don't have to send tapes that often though. Do what seems right for you. You are free to stop receiving consultation from me at any time.

If you are receiving supervision towards EFT Certification it is up to you to keep records of our meetings.
